# FORMAL WEAR

## BABY-MINI 35% YOUNG MISS-ELITE MISS 30%

All contestants will model a formal dress.

Judging based on facial beauty, stage presence, and poise. Contestants are not judged for the type of dress they are wearing but how well it compliments their style and personality as well of the fit of the garment.



We stress individuality when selecting your wardrobe. All competition attire should be professional, tailored and meet National level standards. Makeup is allowed, however application must be age appropriate. Modeling Formation: High Fashion modeling is allowed. Showing your personality while on stage is encouraged. Have fun with your time on stage.

## Clothing Guidelines

0-2 years: length-short, strapless not allowed3-6 years: length can be short or long,strapless not allowed

7-9 years length-long. If wearing a long dress, slits must be to the knee. Strapless not allowed.

10-12 years length-long, Slits must be to the knee. Strapless not allowed.

13+ years length -long, Strapless allowed.



Dresses showing the midriff completely are not allowed for any age, cut outs are acceptable. All should be age appropriate. Each contestant will have 45 seconds to model their formal wear on stage.

# OPEN FASHION

## BABY-MINI 35% YOUNG MISS-ELITE MISS 30%

All contestants will model a professional high fashion professional pants suit, short or skirt outfit or a dress (not a formal pageant dress) of their personal style. Judging based on facial beauty, stage presence and poise.





Note: fashion can be as simple or formal as you like. Event costumes not allowed.



# MODELING GUIDELINES

At UM we want to see your personality during your time on stage. Relax, be yourself and shine on the stage!! All contestants will be alloted 45 seconds on stage for their modeling presentation. When the next contestant is called to enter the stage that is your cue to exit the stage. We encourage you to enter modeling optionals to get practice and feedback. Free open stage practice will also be scheduled during the week. (check schedule for times)

# INTERVIEW 0-2/3-6

## BABY-MINI 30%

Age-appropriate Sunday's Best/Tailored
Dress (NOT a formal pageant dress),
skirt/jacket combo, or a pant outfit can
be worn. Each contestant will be allotted
3 min total for interview.



Contestants in the Universal Baby division—will have an escort who will introduce the contestant to the judges and will be given this time to share a few fun facts about the contestant.

Universal Mini Division- Contestants will meet with their panel of judges one-on-one, will introduce themselves, and will be given a series of age-appropriate questions by the appointed moderator.

Judging will be based on the contestants confidence, poise, overall appearance, ability to answer the questions given, and personality.




# INTERVIEW 7+

## YOUNG MISS-ELITE MISS 30%

Age-appropriate professional interview tailored dress or business suit (skirt and pants allowed).
All should be age appropriate.







Judging will be based on the contestants confidence, poise, overall appearance, ability to answer the questions given, and personality. Political and religious questions will NOT be given.

Each contestant will be allotted 3 min total for interview.



# INTERVIEW INFORMATION

All contestants WILL go through a short interview session. Each contestant will be allotted 3 minutes for their complete session. UM interview allows the judges to get one-on-one time with each contestant. There will be a moderator asking age-appropriate questions to each contestant. Each contestant will come in one at a time. Stand on the X placed in front of the judges table.

Contestants ages 0-2 years will come into the room with their escort. The escort will be directed to say the contestants name and age. Then the escort will be directed by the moderator to give a short introduction about the contestant. The escort should tell the judges some fun facts about the contestant. The moderator will then open up conversation with the escort asking questions about the contestants to help the judges get to know the contestant better.

Contestants ages 3+ years will begin by giving a short introduction including their name, age and state/regional representing followed by the moderators questions. Once the contestants questions are done, they will be directed to exit the room. At that point their interview session will be completed.

### Example Questions-

Age divisions Universal Mini-Universal Young Miss: What is your favorite holiday?

Where is your favorite place to go out and eat? What is your favorite school subject or what game do you like to play outside?

Age Divisions Universal Preteen-Universal Teen: What after school activities are you involved in? What do you plan on becoming when you grow up? What is your favorite book? What do you enjoy doing on the weekends?

Age Divisions Universal Jr. Miss-Universal Elite Miss: What are some things that help you de-stress? Where do you see yourself in the next decade? What makes you special? How can you help mentor the youth?

# PERSONAL INTRODUCTION

## YOUNG MISS-ELITE MISS ONLY 10%

Contestants will have 45 seconds to introduce themselves on stage in front of the judges and the audience by saying their name, state, and something interesting about themselves and/or their future goals. Embrace You and be proud to share how amazing and unique you are! Judging will be based on execution, content, and personality. Note: any introduction going over the time limit, deductions will be given.



UM T-shirt (provided at registration) to be paired with any bottoms of your choosing. No regulation on shoes.

# DIVISIONAL QUEEN PARTIES

## YOUNG MISS-ELITE MISS ONLY

Queen divisional parties and Meet & Greet will now be combined. This is a fun way for contestants to enjoy getting to know their divisional queen/girls in their division. Each division will have their own party during Nationals week. Party times will be listed on the final National schedule. Very casual, wear your everyday clothing (if a queen decideds on themed clothing you will be notified ahead of time). Contestants will bring their goody bag gift for their division to distribute. Judges will NOT be present at the divisional parties.

# FINAL NIGHT


All contestants will participate in the opening number for their designated finals. You will learn your walking pattern during the scheduled rehearsal times. Contestants will wear the black outfit they wore for contestant filming paired with nude, black or silver shoes, along with their state/regional screen printed sash. This sash is given to each contestant at contestant check-in on day 1. Make sure this outfit is easy to walk in, no trains or large ball gowns.



Following the opening number, the Top 11

contestants in each division will be called on-stage and will recompete in Open Fashion competition. Each contestant will be given points for this final Open Fashion competition. These points will be added on to their score given from the preliminary competitions. All divisions will have the Top 5 contestants announced on stage. Top 5 results will come from the contestants preliminary PLUS final night Open Fashion scores.

All in Top 5 will re-compete in Formal Wear competition and will be given points that will be added on to their preliminary scores. With the exception of the Baby division, all divisions will be given a final on-stage question. At the conclusion of final questions, the judges will be escorted out of the room and they will be given the rank of each division's top 5 based on scores they were given in preliminary competition PLUS final night competitions. They will then be asked to collectively rank their top 5- Winner through 4th alternate per division. Once the judge's ranking is complete, final results will be announced.





## Contestant Check-In

All contestants need to come with hair and makeup done wearing an elevated casual outfit to Contestant Check-In. No athletic wear - Think interview attire but NOT as dressy. Wear your monogrammed state sash, NO crown. All contestants will have a professional photo taken at checkin, this photo will be used throughout Nationals week on all UM social media platfoms.

## Contestant Introduction Filming

All contestants are REQUIRED to bring their own contestant introduction outfit for filming (see the schedule for this date/time). This outfit should show your personality and can be a short dress, pant/short suit, romper or skirt outfit. This outfit should be trendy and NOT a formal evening gown. The color of your outfit must be primarily black. Contestants in Divisions Universal Mini through Universal Elite Miss will be given opening number earrings provided by The Bling Boss Studios! These will be given out during contestant check-in.





# State/Regional Sash

Every contestant will receive a white screen printed sash naming the state or region she is representing at nationals. Contestants will be required to wear this banner during Contestant Filming and for Final Night Opening Number. This banner will be given free of charge. If a second banner is needed a \$5.00 fee will be charged. Please bring safety pins to attach your sash/banner to your outfits!

# Program Book Photo

Each contestant will get a keepsake program book as part of their mandatory fees. Additional copies will be on sale during the week. Photos should be a PROFESSIONAL head and shoulders shot -color photos preferred. You will need to upload your photo(s) to the Dropbox links that will be emailed directly to you no later than May 15, 2024 Please include the contestants full name and division with your upload.



# M GIFT EXCHANGE!

## CONTESTANTS WILL GET TO EXCHANGE FUN GOOD LUCK GOODIES WITH THEIR FELLOW CONTESTANTS IN THEIR AGE GROUP!

This is a fun way for each contestant to mix and mingle with their group. Each contestant is required to supply a fun inexpensive little happy for each girl in their group plus their reigning National winner. These goodies should be thoughtful and something that they can use during the week of competition.

For example, the younger contestants LOVE a snack in between competition times so it would be nice to get each girl in your age group a little gummy snack or nutfree snack! Older contestants can never get enough of makeup wipes, Chapstick or chocolate! These all make for fun little gifts to exchange with the girls in your age group only! Each gift should be tagged with your name, and you can include a simple saying like "Good Luck From ..." You can include your picture on each tag too! Have fun with this!! Remember please do not give anything that could be a choking hazard for the younger contestants and do not give anything with nuts to avoid allergic reactions. You will need to provide for your age group ONLY- you can estimate 20-30 girls in your group, but the exact number of girls will be given to all contestants following the pageant deadline. Baby & Mini contestants will bring their gifts with them to contestant check-in, Young Miss through Elite Miss will bring their gifts with them to their divisional queen party.

Non-compete clause- National winners will be required to sign a one-year contract that prohibits them from competing in any other "like" pageants that have a non-compete clause for the duration of their reign.

Under contract National Winners must abide by the following rules/regulations:

- 1. Must maintain a professional reputation on all social media platforms during the duration of her reign. In fitting with the standards maintained by UM parents of National winners must do the same.
  - 2. Must attend at least the finals of their state/regional pageant for the following state/regional season, if applicable. We recommend all national winners attend as many state/regional and local competitions throughout their reign as possible. Remember the more you put into your reign the more you get out of it.
    - 3. Must maintain a professional appearance at all times for all appearances related to UM. This includes hair, make-up, and clothing.
- 4. Must attend the full week of Nationals the following year to pass the title to the next divisional winner. Housing, badges, party packs, and remaining scholarship will be given to all national winners completing their yearly reign.

A contract with full details will be given to each newly crowned national winner following their grand finals.






